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REQUIREMENTS FOR CONFERENCE MATERIALS

Volume – 2 or 3 **full** pages of A-4 format in Microsoft Word version 6.0 and higher (.doc, .docx); font – Times New Roman, size – 14, line spacing – 1.0; paragraph indent – 1.0 cm, margins – 2 cm.

If the abstract contains tables, formulas and (or) illustrations, they should be compact, have a title, and the text font should be Times New Roman, size – 14 pt. (if there are links under tables, figures – text font – Times New Roman, size – 12 pt., italic).

The size of tables and illustrations should not exceed the width of the page.

The number of tables and illustrations should be appropriate. Numerical material should be presented in a table with a sequential number (e.g., Table 1.) and a

title (centered above the table in bold). Figures should also be numbered and titled, with the title centered below the figure in bold (e.g. **Fig. 2. Advantages of Efficient Demand Structuring**)

The sequence of placing materials in the abstract: author(s)'s surname and initials (in bold); academic degree, title (if any), position, and place of work (study) (in italic); city of the institution or organization, country, email address; one line space; title of the abstract (uppercase, bold); main text.

References (without duplicates) should be listed at the end under the heading "References" according to the Ukrainian National Standard DSTU 8302:2015 "Information and Documentation. Bibliographic Reference. General Rules". In-text citations are indicated in square brackets with the source number and page(s), e.g., [1, p. 45].

The file should be named in Ukrainian or English according to the author's surname and initials (e.g., Руснак А.В. / Rusnak A.).
